

# THE MUMMY AND THE MAGIC Hat



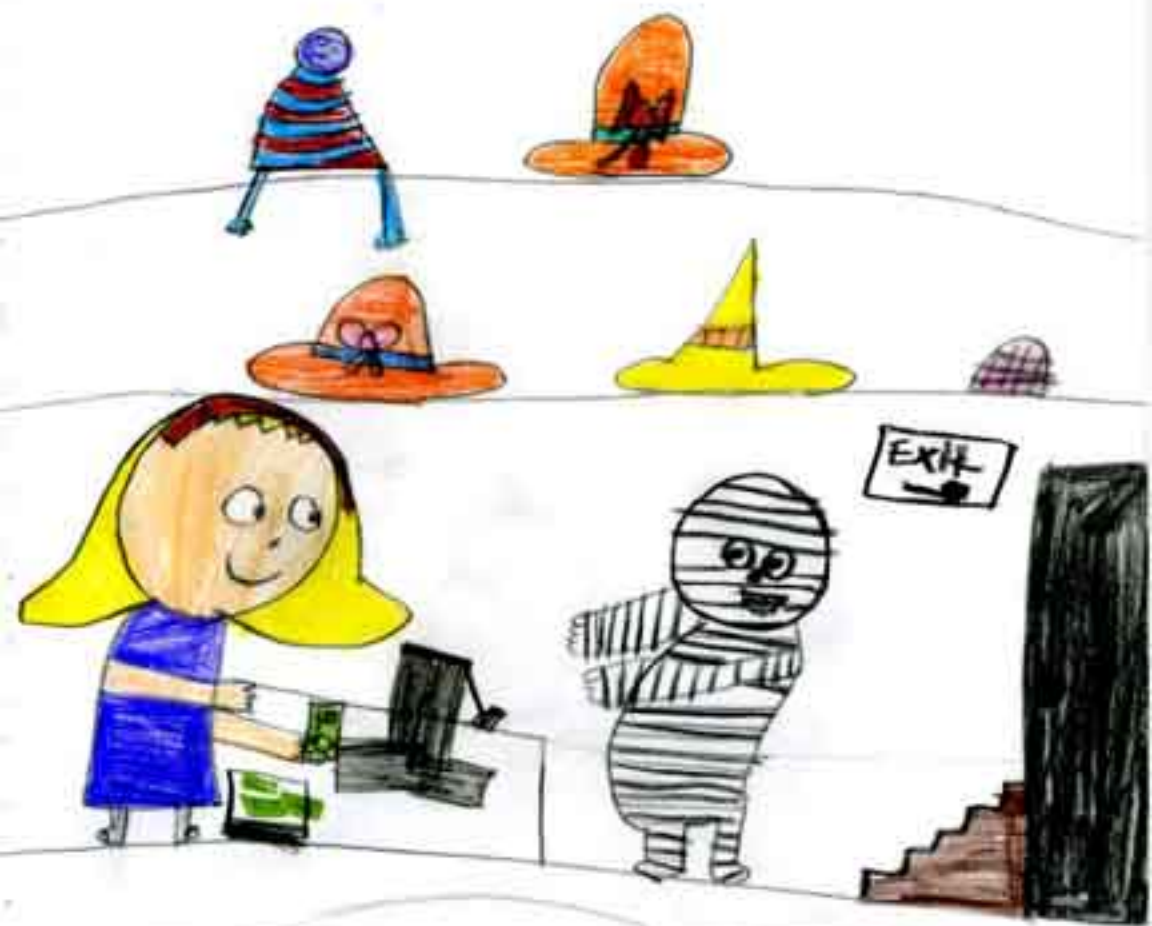
